13 years after Dr.K.C.G. Verghese' demise, I am delighted to release the newsletter documenting the various noteworthy activities of the Charitable Foundation established in his name. A man of great vision, his success was in lighting the darkness and forging a new path by which service to humanity can be rendered in the most effective way without compromising on quality.

Dr. K.C.G. Verghese, Founder of Hindustan Group of Institutions was a philanthropist who served the society throughout his life. His contributions to the needy and underprivileged especially in the field of Education are immeasurable.

He was a dedicated leader of the International organization, "Y's Men International" a worldwide service organization. Y's Men clubs served as a platform for Dr. KCG Verghese to serve the needy, destitute, senior citizens residing in old age homes, children in orphanages, leprosy patients and cancer patients etc., He donated dialysis machines to reduce the cost of dialysis to the patients who couldn't afford the cost of treatment. He also initiated and conducted several free health check up camps.

In order to continue his service, Dr. KCG Verghese Charitable Foundation was established in the year 2006 and right from its inception various service projects were undertaken by the Foundation benefitting the underprivileged society.

Our Country with the poorest of the poor and sickness being all around the focus

of our Charitable Foundation from day one, in 2006 has been health care and education. Dr. K.C.G.Verghese had an undying passion to serve the society not only through education but also in their day to day life. He left no stone unturned during his entire life for the upliftment of the society and contributed to the nation. Dr. KCG Verghese ensured that affected people are provided with food and also medical facilities whenever there was a natural calamity or disaster.

During 2015 floods in Chennai the Foundation provided relief materials and assisted the flood victims. Flash floods that battered the neighbouring state Kerala in the year 2018, resulted in loss of lives and multitude were rendered homeless. Dr KCG Verghese Charitable Foundation of Hindustan Group of Institutions (HGI) stood up and formed an emergency rescue team. The Foundation initiated a Movement "Hindustan 4 Kerala" towards rebuilding the flood ravaged Kerala. Dr KCG Verghese Charitable Foundation and management of HGI presented a cheque for Rs.50 lakhs to the Chief Minister of Kerala towards flood relief fund and also sent two trucks of relief materials worth Rs. 30 lakhs.

Following the appreciable and focused way in which we were able to supply deliverables to the most needy during the 2015 floods and Kerala floods, again when our State of Tamilnadu was ravaged by the forces of nature by the Gaja Cyclone in 2018, we stood by our brethren to supply resources and materials.

The sensitisation of our students in the energy and enthusiasm with which they involved headlong indicates that education without empathy is of no use to humanity. This was demonstrated by the way the students from each unit of the group took initiative to come up with innovative solutions in the devastated regions. A generous contribution from the Charitable Foundation to the Chief Minister's Relief Fund of Rs.25 lakhs was handed over by the Management on January 31st 2019.

We humbly thank each and every staff, students, vendors and especially the Rotary Club of Chennai Capital who have contributed relief materials, funds and their mite to alleviate the pain and suffering of their fellow citizens.

More recently was the donation of Rs. 6,00,000/- to the Headway Foundation, in partnership with the Y'smen Club of OMR for providing wheel chairs to the physically challenged in the presence of noted film personality, Actor Padmasri.Kamal Hassan who visited the University on January 25, 2019.

The vision of our late founder Chairman, as a group which has recently celebrated 50 years, we would like to carry forward with care, compassion and concern.

The editorial team has done a cohesive and commendable work in highlighting the few drops we are able to serve in this ocean of need. We exhort you in strengthening our hand to continue the Chairman's legacy and serve humanity.


