COMMUNITY SERVICE



As part of the Community Service, Dr.K.C.G. Verghese Charitable Foundation along with the Hindustan Group of Institutions distributed 50 tones of rice bags to the people living in and around Karapakkam, Kelambakkam, Arambakkam Navalur, Chinnandikuppam, Thalambur, who were affected by the recent MICHAUNG Cyclone, which impacted the lives of many in the Chennai City. Rice bags were also sent to Tuticorin to be distributed in the flood-affected areas.



Smart Class Rooms – For the Government High School, Kelambakkam, Tiruppur Panchayat, where more than 800 children are studying, had no proper classroom for higher standards. Based on the request of the School Head Master, Dr.K.C.G. Verghese Charitable Foundation along with Hindustan College of Arts & Science in association with the Indo Australian Association has set up a smart classroom with Interactive Display system and the inauguration ceremony was held on 14/2/2023.

An amount of Rs.5 lakhs donated to Navajeeva Kendram, Pathanamthitta, Kerala towards the expansion of their De-addiction and Rehabilitation Centre.

An amount of Rs.2 lakhs was contributed towards the Construction of rest rooms in the Women Police at Kannagi Nagar, Karapakkam.

An amount of Rs. 2 lakhs was donated towards the Good Samaritan Day at St. Pauls Mar Thoma Church, Velachery through which they distribute Food, Clothes to the poor and needy during Christmas time.

Distribution of 10 Wheel Chairs to the Physically Challenged and 10 Sewing Machines worth Rs. 2,12,400/- to the self help group of HITS adopted villages in Padur, Kelambakkam, Pudupakkam, Kayar and Thandalam.
